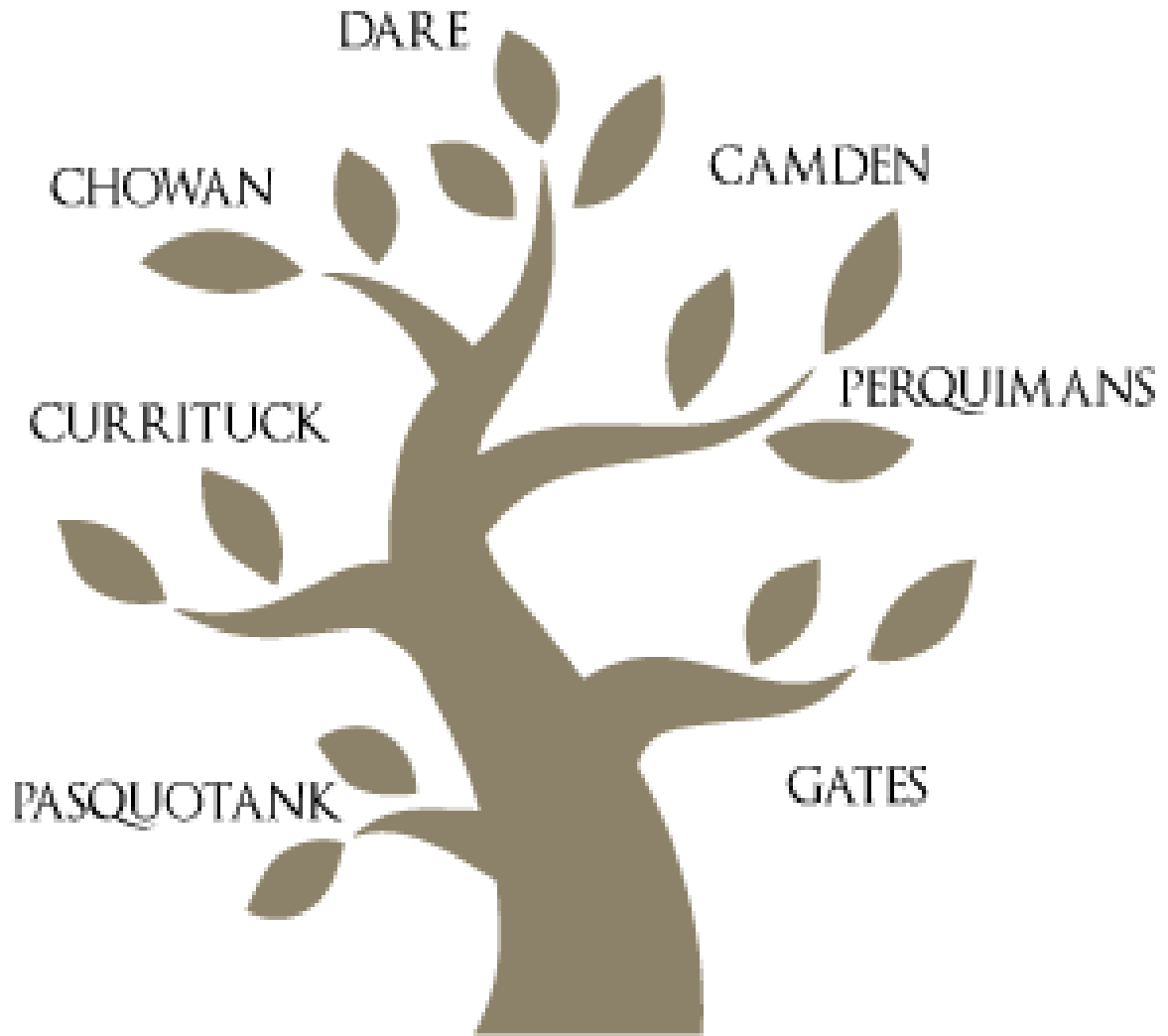

This describes realistic situations that the Currituck County Baum family (Joseph b 1780) had to put up with such as the water level of the Dismal Swamp Canal impacting their ability to take their goods to the market in Norfolk, the British impressing Americans from small crafts and boats around the War of 1812, the ague affecting people in Hyde County who moved there from another county such as Pasquotank, etc. Joseph lived in Currituck, married his fiancée who lived in Elizabeth City after her parents died in Camden County, arranged for an architect in Edenton draw his house plans for his new house in Hyde County, the move back to Currituck when ague started impacting his wife's health, etc. Everyday items like as getting a doctor or midwife, educating children, going to the monthly church meetings, the trips across the sound depending on which way the wind was blowing, finding your land when there were no markers, street signs, etc., finding squatters on your land or stealing your building supplies, etc as well as the everyday interaction of whites, slaves, and free people of color both Negro and Indian.
